

ENERGY SIDE EVENT Theme: Energy Security –Promoting Energy Efficiency At Delhi Sustainable Development Summit 2006 01 February 2006; The Oberoi Hotel, New Delhi

In order to initiate a discussion on mainstreaming sustainable development concerns for ensuring energy security in the country, **TERI-BCSD India in association with the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) is organizing a side event, 'Energy Security –promoting energy efficiency ', prior to the summit, on 01 February 2006 at The Oberoi Hotel, New Delhi.**

Promoting energy efficiency assumes special significance in the context of our effort to ensure energy security. This assumes added importance in countries like India, where there are huge peak and energy deficits. There is a need to create awareness and implement policies and programs that promote energy conservation and efficiency in Industrial, commercial and residential sectors. There also exists considerable scope in improving efficiency in the supply side. All this could contribute to better competitiveness of products less environmental impacts, improving electrification level, etc.
