

HE MR JAN DUSÍK

Minister of the Environment of the Czech Republic

HE Mr Jan Dusík graduated from the Law School of Charles University, Prague, and the University of Oxford (Environmental Change and Management). He has represented the Czech Republic as the Head of Delegation to the conferences and meetings of global and regional environmental conventions and international organisations. He served as the Vice–President of the Bureau of the 24th Session of the Governing Council of UNEP during 2007–09 and has been the Chairman of the Bureau of the



4th Meeting of the Parties to the Aarhus Convention in 2008–11. He was the leading coordinator of the Czech Presidency of the EU in the first half of 2009 concerning environmental issues. Jan Dusík was appointed as the Minister of the Environment of the Czech Republic in December 2009.
