

NOBEL LAUREATE PROFESSOR JAMES MIRRLEES

Professor of Political Economy, University of Cambridge, UK



Professor James Mirrlees studied Mathematics at Edinburgh and Cambridge and holds a PhD in Economics from University of Cambridge. His illustrious academic career includes Lecturer at Cambridge (1963–68); Professor at Oxford (1968–95); and Professor at Cambridge (1995–2003); Professor Mirrlees is currently College Master, Chinese University of Hong Kong. He was the President of the Econometric Society (1983) and Royal Economic Society (1989). Professor Mirrlees won the Nobel Prize for Economics in 1996.
