Special Advisor to the Cabinet in charge of Climate Change, Japan



Being a foreign service officer of Japan, he was Consul-General in Chicago in 1994. Then he became Director-General for European Affairs Bureau of Gaimusho in 1997. He was Ambassador to the OECD (1999–2002) and to Mexico (2003–2005).

Since 2005, he was Ambassador-in-charge of Global Environment and chief climate negotiator for the Government of Japan. In 2008, he was appointed Special Advisor to the Cabinet in charge of climate change. Since 2010, he is a member of UN Secretary-General's High-level Advisory Group on Climate Change Financing (AGF).
