Minister of Agriculture, Water Resources and Fisheries, Burkina Faso



Mr Laurent Gouind Sedogo has a doctorate in participatory land use planning and sustainable land management. Since March 2008, he is serving as the Minister of Agriculture, Water Resources, and Fisheries. From January 2004 to March 2008, he held the position of Minister of Environment of Burkina Faso. He is also Vice President of the Bureau of the UNEP Governing Council. From 1984 to 1987, he occupied several high administrative and political positions and was among the pioneers who set up the national committee for desertification control in Burkina Faso. From 1988 to 1990, he was appointed as Minister of Farmers' Cooperatives. From 1991 to 1993, he was the manager of the desertification control programme (LUCODEB) at the Ministry of Environment.
