Currently, the Director at the World Meteorological Organization (UN, Geneva), Dr Petteri Taalas was previously Scientist and Senior Scientist at Finnish Meteorological Institute; Research Manager and later Research Professor at FMI; and Director General of the FMI. Dr Taalas

is the leader of several international and national research and development programmes in such as global change, ozone, UV radiation, atmospheric chemistry-climate interactions, satellite programmes for monitoring atmospheric chemistry and meteorology, and Arctic and Antarctic research, funded by European Commission, EUMETSAT, ESA, NASA, Finnish Academy, Finnish Technology Development Centre, and so on. He is the author of 40 peer-reviewed papers in international journals and is the lead author of Arctic Climate Impact Assessment and EU Assessment on Climate-Chemistry interactions. Dr Taalas holds MSc degree in meteorology and a PhD in meteorology from Helsinki University.
