We have in this Report, sought to arrive at a policy framework that enables the co-evolution of economic development and ecological sustainability in a very sensitive and ecological valuable ecosystem such as the Western Ghats.

We believe that we have been objective, true to the values of our Constitution, honestly undertaken what we were mandated to do, followed a transparent and participatory process, and not yielded to political expediency and what is generally considered "implementable".
