Christian Siderius

Christian Siderius is an adaptation and water resources management expert whose research focuses on the influence of climate variability and extremes on people's vulnerability and adaptation strategies, with specific attention to economic dimensions of flexibility and diversification.

Currently, he works on decision making under uncertainty in central and southern Africa (UMFULA and El Nino projects) at the Grantham Research Institute of the London School of Economics, and he coordinates participatory research on water and heat stress adaptation in different pilot areas in South Asia under the 'HI-AWARE' project, being part-time employed by Wageningen Environmental Research in the Netherlands.

Next to analysing the more biophysical processes and dynamics at catchment scale, the integration of people's choices and strategies in land use and water allocation to deal with climate variability and the use of scenarios in integrated water resources management has his special attention.
