Leckey Dorji is currently the Bhutanese Minister for Economic Affairs, Chairman for Punatsangchhu Hydroelectric Project Authority-I (PHPA-I), Punatsangchhu Hydroelectric Project Authority-II (PHPA-II), Mangdechhu Hydroelectric Project Authority (MHPA), Bhutan Standard Bureau (BSB), Empowered Joint Group (EJG), Vice Chairman of Tourism Council of Bhutan (TCB), Better Business Council (BBC) and Member on the Governing Board of National Environment Commission (NEC).

Dorji was a Fulbright Scholar in US, a Recipient of the ITU Fellowship in UK, and is an author of Democracy Up-close: documentary study of Bhutan's first Democratic Local Government Elections. He is a former Board Director of NRDCL and T Bank Limited, Member of Academic Board of the Royal University of Bhutan, and Former Executive Member of IT Association of Bhutan. Dorji is an entrepreneur who has setup Samden Technology Private Limited, New Edge Technologies Private Limited, LEKEY DORJI & Associates and others. Dorji is a Former Executive Member, SAARC Chamber of Commerce and Industry; and former consultant to ADB, World Bank, JICA, SEDF, DANIDA, UNDP, UNCTAD and Tashi Group of Companies to set up Tashi Cell.
