## VICE ADMIRAL P.J. JACOB (RETD.), PVSM, AVSM, VSM

Vice Admiral P J Jacob retired in 2001 as the Vice Chief of the Naval Staff. An alumnus of the National Defence Academy, Defence Services Staff College, and the National Defence College, he has held a variety of key Operational and Training assignments in a career spanning forty years. He has commanded the Eastern Fleet and also been Director General of the Indian Coast Guard and was active in strategic planning and charting the future development of the Indian Navy. He has overseen numerous training initiatives and has led several Ministry of Defence / Navy delegations to negotiate intergovernmental agreements on strategic issues with various countries. Admiral Jacob is vastly experienced in the field of Maritime Security, an issue that is of growing relevance. He has participated in India Taiwan Dialogue which was organized by National Institute of Advanced Studies, CII and Dua Consulting in 2005. He has also visited Taiwan to participate in Taiwan-India-Japan Strategic Dialogue on Regional Security and has presented Regional Maritime Security with focus on sea lines of communication. He continues to participate in seminars on Geo-Strategic and Maritime Security issues conducted by Asia Centre, Bangalore International Centre and the National Institute of Advanced Studies.
