

Dr. Dileep Mavlankar is the Director of the Indian Institute of Public Health-Gandhinagar (IIPHG). He is a doctor by training, with an MD in Preventive and Social Medicine from the Gujarat University, and a Doctor of Public Health Degree from Johns Hopkins University. He was a post-doctoral fellow at the National Institute of Health (NIH) in USA.
