











Youth Climate Conclave

Youth Climate Conclave is envisaged as a competitive and educative mode of action, wherein youth from across the country are invited to join hands to address issues of climate change. Highlights of the conclave are *photography* and *blogging* competitions for passionate budding environmentalists who wish to create a better future with innovative sustainable solutions. Winners will have the chance to attend the Youth Climate Conclave in the end of January 2020, which will focus on accelerating climate action through a series of meaningful dialogues that will lead to a Youth declaration on Climate Change to be presented during World Sustainable Development Summit in January 2020.

The programme is a part of the EU funded Strategic Partnership for Implementation of the Paris Agreement (SPIPA) project.

Guidelines for Photography Contest

- 1. Each student is required to submit one photograph on the following theme:
 - Climate Action: A World of Possibilities
- 2. Entries can be submitted in the following age categories:
 - a. 13 18 years and
 - b. 19 25 years
- 3. Only one entry per student will be accepted; however there is no limit to number of students who can apply from each school / college.
- 4. Applicant should submit an original photograph that conveys his / her understanding of the theme. The picture should convey hopeful and meaningful messages. It should devoid of doomsday prophecies.
- 5. By entering the contest, applicant represents, acknowledges and warrants that the submitted photograph and description is original work created solely by the applicant and that no other party has any right, title, claim or interest in the photograph or the description. If the entry is found to be copied, the student will be expelled from the contest immediately.
- 6. Minor adjustments, including the removal of sensor dust or scratches on scans of negatives, dodging and burning, sharpening, contrast, toning, slight color adjustment and conversion to grayscale are acceptable. The addition and subtraction of objects is not permitted.
- 7. The entry without a title, description and details mentioned above will be rejected.
- 8. Only high resolution (2 MB or more) photograph will be accepted. The photograph should be necessarily in JPG format with at least 200 dpi at 2,000 pixels.













- 9. Obscene, provocative, or otherwise objectionable content will not be considered.
- 10. Please submit the photographs without any copyrights or watermarks. By entering the contest, all applicants grant permission to the organizers to reproduce their photographs in their original or updated form, without any notification, permission, fee or any other form of compensation. Photographs will be credited to the photographer.
- 11. The following criteria would be used to judge the entries:
 - Resolution
 - Clarity of the photograph
 - Meaningful and impactful
- 12. All expenses incurred during shooting process will have to be borne by the participants.
- 13. 12 best photos will be converted into the 2020 Calendar and will also be promoted through social networking platforms and organizers' website.
- 14. Winners will receive certificates along with other exciting prizes and a chance to attend the Youth Climate Conclave 2020 during World Sustainable Development Summit 2020.
- 15. Last date to apply for the contest is 29 November 2019.
