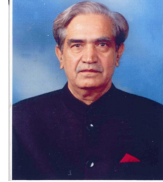


MR NAMO NARAIN MEENA

HON'BLE MINISTER OF STATE FOR ENVIRONMENT, MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS, GOVERNMENT OF INDIA

Mr Namon Narain Meena has a Masters degree in Geography from Rajasthan University and thereafter joined the Indian Police Service in the year 1969. During his illustrious career in the Indian Police Service, he served as Assistant Superintendent of Police (1969-73), Superintendent of Police (1973-87), Deputy Inspector General of Police (1987-93), Inspector General of Police (1993-99), and Additional Director General of Police (1999-2003). He received President Police Medal and President's Distinguished Service Medal in view of the illustrious service that he put in. He attended the Overseas Command Course in 1989 in United Kingdom. He voluntarily relinquished the Service as Additional Director General of Police of Rajasthan State to join the Rajasthan State Human Rights Commission as its Member.



Taking up the call of public service further, Mr Meena became a Member of Parliament in the 14th Lok Sabha. He joined the Council of Ministers as the Minister of State for Environment and Forests in which he is handling matters relating to environment currently.
