Dr. Baru has been Chief Editor, The Financial Express (India), Associate Editor, The Economic Times (India), and Editorial Page Editor, The Times of India. He has also been a TV anchor on Star TV and Doordarshan, and has appeared on several television discussion panels on BBC, CNN, CNBC, Star TV, NDTV, and other Indian TV channels. He has taught economics at the University of Hyderabad (India), Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, and the School of Economics & Development Studies, University of East Anglia, UK. He was Professor at the ICRIER (Indian Council for Research in International Economic Relations). In 2000, Dr Baru was J Watamull Fellow at East-West Center, Hawaii.



Dr Baru's research work has spanned a wide range of areas including Indian industrial, fiscal, and trade policies and regional aspects of Indian development, with a focus on emergence of first-generation business enterprise. He was Member of India's National Security Advisory Board in 1998–2001, and drafted the chapter on 'Economic Security' for India's first-ever Strategic Defence Review. His research in this area finds expression in the book, Strategic Consequences of India's Economic Performance. His other publications include, The Political Economy of Indian Sugar, and several essays in journals and newspapers in India and abroad. He is also Member, Governing Board, Centre for Policy Research, New Delhi, and Committee on Economic Security, Confederation of Indian Industries.
