

MR VIKRAM SINGH MEHTA

Chairman, Shell Companies in India

Mr Vikram Singh Mehta is Chairman of the Shell Group of Companies in India since 1994. His career began with the IAS (Indian Administrative Service), Government of India in 1978. He resigned that position in 1980 and joined Philips Petroleum in London as their Senior Economist. He was with Philips Petroleum for four years in London and at their headquarters in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, USA. In 1984, he returned to India to join the public sector oil company 'Oil India Ltd' as its Advisor (Strategic Planning). He resigned from Oil India in 1988 and joined Shell International in London. In 1991, he was posted to Egypt as the Managing Director for Shell Markets and Chemicals, Egypt. In 1994, he returned to India as the Chairman of the Shell Group in India.



Mr Mehta was a member of the National Council of the CII (Confederation of Indian Industry) and Chairman of its hydrocarbons committee. He is a non-executive Director of Colgate Palmolive India Ltd and Indian Public Schools Society. He is a member of the Board of Overseers of the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy. Mr Mehta has a BA (Hons) degree in Mathematics from St Stephens College, Delhi University, an MA in Economics from Magdalen College, Oxford University and an MA from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, Tufts University.
