

MR HAMEED ULLAH JAN AFRIDI

Minister for Environment, Government of Pakistan



Mr Hameed Ullah Jan Afridi has been appointed as Federal Minister for Environment, Government of Pakistan on 31 March 2008. A graduate and MBA degree holder from Punjab University, he worked as Executive Officer in Oil Marketing Company for nine years in different areas of the

country. He worked as social worker and remained with National Rural Support Programme (NRSP) for Social mobilization, poverty alleviation through community participation in rural areas of Pakistan. He established FATA Rural Support Programme (FRSP) on the pattern of NRSP to improve the living standards of the people and provide health and education related facilities to the people of FATA. The purpose of this programme was to create awareness in tribal people with a view to bring tribal areas at par with rest of the country in development projects. He was elected member to the Senate in February 2003.
