

Mr. Manjeev Singh Puri is India's Ambassador to the European Union, Belgium and Luxembourg. Prior to his posting in Brussels, he was Ambassador and Deputy Permanent Representative of India to the UN in New York, having served there from 2009 to 2013.

Ambassador Puri was actively involved with issues of sustainable development and environment and was a lead negotiator in India's delegation for the UN Conference on Sustainable Development held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil in June 2012. He was a key member of India's delegation at various Climate Change negotiations, including the Major Economies Forum and the Conference of Parties of the UNFCCC in Copenhagen in December 2009. Ambassador Puri served on the Board of the Asia-Pacific Partnership on Clean Development and Climate and is on the Advisory Board of TERI.

An officer of the Indian Foreign Service, from 2005-09 he headed the United Nations Division in the Ministry of External Affairs in New Delhi dealing with economic and social issues. His charge included global economic and development issues, environment, climate change, sustainable development and, human rights. He was closely involved with India's participation in the G8-G5 Summits from 2005-08.
