Dr. Genevieve Connors is the Program Leader for Water and Sustainability in the India Country Office of the World Bank, where she currently works on new operations and analytical work in sustainable development, including water, environment, agriculture, disaster management and climate change. Previously, for two years, she supervised implementation of the National Ganga River Basin Project, a priority project for the Bank to support cleaning and rejuvenation of the river. From 2013 to 2014, she was Acting Program Leader for the South Asia Water Initiative (SAWI) which aims to increase regional cooperation in the management of Himalayan river systems. Her interests are in inter-jurisdictional and transboundary water challenges – including river basin management and water quality. She has worked in the basins of the Ganges, the Nile, and the Danube. She has a B.A. from Columbia, an M.Phil. from Cambridge, and a Ph.D. in Urban and Regional Planning from MIT.
