

## **Chencho Norbu**

Chencho Norbu has a Masters degree in Soil Science from Cornell University, Ithaca, NY, USA. Currently he is serving as the Secretary to the National Environment Commission, and as Focal Person of UNFCCC. He has served as the Director General of the Department of Forests and Park Services, and Director of Department of Agriculture under the Ministry of Agriculture and Forests. He has also served as the Focal Person for UN Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD).
