Instituted in 2001, the Summit's mission is making 'sustainable development' a globally shared goal. As the only independently convened international summit on sustainable development and the environment based in the Global South, WSDS strives to provide long-term solutions for the benefit of global communities by assembling world leaders on a single platform.

The 2026 edition of WSDS will mark the **Silver Jubilee** of the Summit. This 25th edition of the milestone event will be held from **25–27 February 2026** at the **Taj Palace, New Delhi**, under the umbrella theme: **परिवर्तन** | **Transformations**: **Vision, Voices, and Values for Sustainable Development**.

We are living in a defining moment for humanity and the planet. The first Global Stocktake makes it clear that the world is far from the trajectory required to achieve the Paris Agreement goals, with only a fraction of the necessary emission reductions being realised. Likewise, the mid-point review of the Sustainable Development Goals reveals serious gaps, with most targets off track and some not even being measured. These stark realities underscore the urgent need for systemic change—driven by vision, inclusivity, and shared values. Against this backdrop, the 25th edition of the World Sustainable Development Summit (WSDS) will mark its Silver Jubilee under the theme: परिवर्तन | Transformations: Vision, Voices, and Values for Sustainable Development. The Summit will serve as a milestone platform to inspire transformations and shape global agendas, including those of the G20, BRICS, UNFCCC COP, and sustainable development.
