Introduction

In February 2024, The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) will convene the World Sustainable Development Summit (WSDS) for a 23rd time under the umbrella theme "Leadership for Sustainable Development and Climate Justice". With the halfway point of implementing the 2030 Agenda passed, it is becoming increasingly clear that global efforts need to ramp up significantly to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by 2030.

Effectively delivering sustainable, resilient, and innovative solutions is necessary to reinforce the 2030 Agenda and to eradicate poverty. This will be the key theme during this year's High-Level Political Forum, where progress on the 2030 Agenda and the SDGs will be reviewed, with specific focus on SDG 1 (No Poverty), SDG 2 (Zero Hunger), SDG 13 (Climate Action), SDG 16 (Peace and Strong Institutions), and 17 (Partnerships for the Goals).

Entering the second half of the Decade of Action and Delivery, the panel will discuss on how implementation, especially of environmental SDGs, must ramp up, and what guidance can be derived from the GSDR and the SDG Summit.

In this regard, this session shall explore how synergies between climate action and SDG implementation can be maximized by exploring guidance from the Global Sustainable Development report, the SDG Summit as well as national policy plans and current research.
